

Visiting the Jeffrey Cheah Biomedical Centre (JCBC), during the COVID-19 Re-Occupation

- Access to the JCBC is via the access-controlled pass door at the front of the building, this will only be between 08.00-18.00 for visitors. No visitors are allowed outside of these hours.
- No Scrubs are to be worn within the JCBC.
- Everyone entering the JCBC must use the hand sanitizers and foot spray. There are additional sanitizers throughout the JCBC, including breakout areas, the canteen and key offices. These should be used regularly throughout the day.
- Visitors are now strongly encouraged to wear face masks at all times when in the JCBC in line with the University's guidance.
- Visitors must sign in to the JCBC via reception.
- Visitors to core areas must be booked in via the facility head and have read and acknowledged the reading of the guidelines for working in the JCBC.
- Visitors must not put the headcount of the group or facility they are working in over the number set out in the guidelines.
- In line with government guidelines, the 2-metre distancing rule must always be adhered to, please respect people's space and if asked, please keep your distance, especially in lifts (see floor marking in lifts) and meetings. Meetings should be conducted via video conferencing when at all possible, if not possible then please use the larger meeting rooms to maintain a 2-metre distance between participants.
- Any staff or visitors whose live-in family or housemates have displayed symptoms and are self-isolating will be required to also isolate themselves in accordance with the government guideline of 14 days and must not visit the JCBC under any circumstances during this time. Individuals testing positive should follow government and University guidelines for 'test & trace'.
- There is signage around the whole building reminding you to keep 2 metres apart and to clean down communal areas before and after use, please adhere to this for everyone's wellbeing.
