## SCI at the Science Festival



# Publications

## WT & MRC Publication Requirements

The Wellcome Trust and MRC specified the following terms and conditions relating to publications by SCI members:

- All SCI publications must acknowledge the “Wellcome Trust - Medical Research Council Cambridge Stem Cell Institute”
- All SCI publications must be open access
- The SCI must notify the WT & MRC of all publications at least 10 days in advance of their publication date

To assist SCI staff with meeting these requirements the Institute has put in place a publication submission process. As soon as you know a publication has been accepted please email the publication submission form to the SCI Coordinator. We will then liaise with the press offices (at the WT, MRC, University and any other specific sponsors for your paper). We can also pay your open access fees.

You can also do a publication search for SCI members which draws data from the University's symplectic system.

## Symplectic

The Symplectic system manages the publication records for the University: <https://ref.cam.ac.uk/>

This information feeds into the REF, annual reporting for the Institute. We have been updating the records for all members of the SCI and this includes their publications as well as professional activities such as conferences, outreach events, patents etc. Research staff can update their own records in Symplectic. We are currently working on a simple user-guide to Symplectic but in the mean time if you need advice or assistance with updating your records please contact the [SCI Coordinator](#).
